AUDITION NOTES

- If you are aged over 12 years, you will need to provide your vaccination passport.
 - Be prepared. Do your own vocal and physical warm up.
 - Make sure you arrive 10 minutes prior to your audition.
 - Provide a backing track for the song you choose to sing (USB or CD with no lead vocals). You may or may not be required to sing the full song.
 - You will be required to sing scales accompanied by the piano, to assess vocal range.
 - If you would like to play the guitar and/or the piano as part of your audition you are more than welcome to do so.
 - Some acting will be required. The script will be provided at the Information Evening, via email or on audition day.
 - You will be required to learn and perform some stage movement. Please wear appropriate footwear, i.e. no jandals.

The UHMT executive will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, members and visitors need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the health and safety policy.

Each member and visitor is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy environment through:

- Taking reasonable care for your own health and safety
- Taking reasonable care that others are not harmed by something they do, or do not do (you will be legally responsible if you cause someone harm and did not take reasonable care)
- Being involved in the health and safety system
- Following instructions and procedures
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment if and when required
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported to the executive
- Helping new members and visitors to UHMT understand the right safety procedures and why they exist
- Telling a member of the executive immediately of any health and safety concerns
- Keeping the theatre tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls
