



## **HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY**

**18 May 2016**

Upper Hutt Musical Theatre (UHMT) is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all members and visitors, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.

Under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (HSWA), UHMT is not considered a PCBU (Person Conducting Business or Undertaking) as we are a volunteer organisation and do not "employ" people to carry out work for us.

The UHMT executive will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, members and visitors need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the health and safety policy.

Each member and visitor is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy environment through:

- Taking reasonable care for your own health and safety
- Taking reasonable care that others are not harmed by something they do, or do not do (you will be legally responsible if you cause someone harm and did not take reasonable care)
- Being involved in the health and safety system
- Following instructions and procedures
- Wearing protective clothing and equipment if and when required
- Ensuring all accidents and incidents are reported to the executive
- Helping new members and visitors to UHMT understand the right safety procedures and why they exist
- Telling a member of the executive immediately of any health and safety concerns
- Keeping the theatre tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls
